

## PRIVACY POLICY

### COOKIES

Like many other websites, we use Cookie files (hereinafter, cookies) to help us collect and store information about visitors to our website.

Cookies are text files containing a small amount of information that is saved to your device as you navigate a website. A cookie is sent either to the initial website at the time of each subsequent visit or to another website that recognizes this particular cookie. Cookies are useful because they enable a website to identify the user's device.

Cookies serve a variety of purposes — for instance, they improve website navigation by memorizing your preferences and enhancing your user experience. They can also make sure that the advertisements you see online match your lifestyle and interests.

#### WHICH COOKIES ARE USED ON THIS WEBSITE?

The cookies that may be used on this website are Analytical Cookies.

Cookies of this class collect information on the visitor's use of the website, for instance, which pages they view most often and whether they see errors on any of the web pages. Such cookies do not collect data that can be used to identify the user. All the information collected by such cookies is consolidated and therefore anonymous. They are used exclusively for website performance improvement.

#### WHAT KIND OF ANALYTICAL COOKIES DO WE USE ON OUR WEBSITE?

We use the Yandex.Metrics service to analyze the use of our website. This analytical tool uses cookies that represent regular text files stored on your hard drive to gather a standard set of anonymous data about the user's website visits and behavior. The information on your use of the website generated by the cookie (including your IP address) is sent to Yandex. These data are used in the assessment of website user experience and for the compilation of statistic reports about user activities on the website.

#### HOW CAN I ENABLE/DISABLE COOKIES?

You can accept or decline cookies in your browser settings. However, if you disable cookies, you might not be able to use some of the interactive website features.

Cookies can be managed in a multitude of ways. To learn more about cookie management, please refer to your browser's manual or the help screen. For instance, in Internet Explorer you can refer to the Tools/Internet options/Security and Privacy tab to configure the browser according to your preferences. If you use several devices in a number of locations, you will need to make sure that every browser is configured in line with your cookie preferences.

A number of modern browsers can analyze a website's security policy and offer the user the opportunity to control their privacy settings. This functionality is known as P3P (Platform for Privacy Preferences).

You can also easily remove any cookies that have been installed in the Cookies folder of your browser. For instance, if you use Explorer in Microsoft Windows:

- Open Windows Explorer
- Click on Search on the toolbar
- Type "Cookie" in the Search box for Folders and Files
- Select "My Computer" in the "Search in" field
- Click on "Search now" and double click on the folders in search results
- Select any cookie file
- Press Delete on your keyboard.

If you use something other than Microsoft Windows Explorer, you should select "Cookies" in the Help feature to get information on how to locate your cookie folder.
